## Minutes of VILLAGE OF COBDEN LIQUOR ADVISORY BOARD February 16, 2011

The Village of Cobden Liquor Advisory Board met at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 16, 2011 at the Cobden Village Hall.

Those in attendance were: Molly Beckley, Alma Gomez, Wes Wilkins, David Isom, Doug Campbell, Alan Eddington, Margarita Bartolo, Fidel Bartolo, Robert Finster

Mayor Beckley has received a request for a Class D liquor license from the Bartolo family who are the owners of the Taqueria Pequena. Mayor Beckley recommends eliminating one (1) Class B and one (1) Class E license and adding one (1) Class D license to our liquor code.

Mayor Beckley has also received a request for a liquor license from Doug Campbell for Sidecars, although the type of license requested was not noted in the application. Mayor Beckley stated that she is opposed to creating and issuing another liquor license for Sidecars for reasons previously discussed at other meetings. The other members of the Liquor Advisory Board also voiced their opposition to the sale of alcohol at that location.

The Liquor Advisory Board's recommendation to the Village Board will be to:

- Eliminate one (1) Class B liquor license
- Eliminate one (1) Class E liquor license
- Add one (1) Class D liquor license
