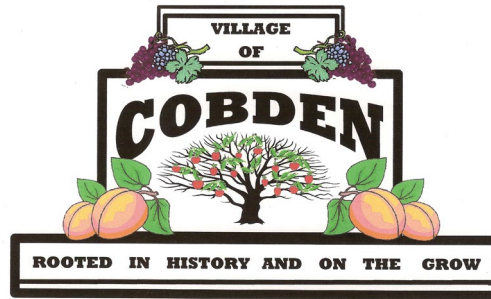

We are happy to once again plan for the Cobden Peach Festival Parade which will be sponsored by the Village of Cobden. We would like to invite you to participate in this annual tradition in downtown Cobden – The Home of the Appleknockers. We welcome all types of entries – color guards, bands, floats, scout units, church groups, kiddy units, performing units, neighborhood groups, families, class reunions, antique/custom autos, tractors, horse units, and any other entry which is appropriate for viewing by children and all citizens.

The Parade Marshal for this year is The Amazing Appleknocker team of 1964 – celebrating 60 years! The parade theme is Appleknocker Pride, but you are not required to follow the theme.

Parade formation will begin at 3:30 p.m. on Locust Street headed east (same as previous years), and the parade will “kick off” at 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, August 10, 2024.

To reach the parade formation site from the south (Anna), travel north through Cobden on Old Route 51 (Front Street), cross over the “bridge” and continue for a right turn at Locust Street – Cobden Community Park. From the north (Carbondale, Murphysboro) on Old Route 51, turn left on Locust prior to entering town. If traveling on New Route 51, cross over the “bridge” and continue for a right turn at Locust Street – Cobden Community Park. A parade volunteer will be on hand to indicate where you turn to locate your parade spot.

Units taking part in the parade will not be judged this year. We are hoping this will not deter you from entering for the fun experience.

Early return of the enclosed entry form will help us with our planning, so please return yours as soon as possible. If you cannot meet the deadline, we will accept entries until the time of the parade.

The Cobden community welcomes you to the parade on August 10. We also hope you will join us at the Peach Festival which is sponsored by the Cobden Lions Club the evenings of Friday, August 9 and Saturday, August 10. Enjoy the great peaches and cream, peach cobbler, food, carnival, entertainment, and queen contest.
