WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

The Village of Cobden is making improvements to its water distribution system. The project includes the installation of approximately 4,300 feet of water main and all the necessary appurtenances along Front Street. To ensure proper water and sewer separation, several storm sewers will also have to be removed and replaced. These changes will allow continued safe and efficient water services for the Village population.

The total estimated cost for the project is \$828,260.90. Of this amount, \$420,000.00 will be in grants and the remaining funding of \$408,260.90 is to be financed over a period of 20 years at an interest rate of 0.83% and will be provided by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Public Water Supply Loan Program. Project Documents are available for inspection by the public at the Cobden Village Hall.
