The construction of a new shelter in the downtown park is complete. The construction was made possible by the work of Village employees, members of the First Baptist Church B-Men, and a donation of \$1,000 from the Cobden Lions Club. Park Committee Chairman David Stewart will organize a cookout for those involved with the project. Tentative date for the cookout is Sunday, October 16.

**Regulation for Use of Golf Carts**

A proposed ordinance for the operation of golf carts on Village streets was presented. Revisions were made and the ordinance and a proposed permit form will be presented at the October 17 meeting.
