### **American Rescue Plan Act Funding and Use**

The Village has been notified that it is eligible to receive \$144,644.64 from the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund allotment. Permissible use of funding is for investment in the infrastructure. Mayor Tomazzoli has spoken with a property owner who is willing to work with the Village in providing a site for an additional water well to alleviate the current water supply issue. Drilling for a test well will be necessary prior to committing to purchasing the property. Motion was made by Hackethal, seconded by Brumleve, to authorize the purchase of the property pending a successful test well. Upon roll call, the vote was:

A Cemetery Board of Managers meeting will be scheduled to discuss the acquisition of property adjacent to the cemetery.

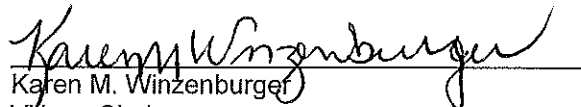
### **Liquor Advisory Board Recommendations for Outdoor Dining**
